## PRESIDENT'S REPORT



As recently advised to all Club members, the health threat posed by Coronavirus (COVID-19) is significant and ongoing. Victoria has the second highest infection rate in the country and the numbers are only expected to increase with time.

On 16 March 2020, the State's Chief Health Officer declared a State of Emergency for the state of Victoria. This declaration runs until 13 April 2020 but it may be extended beyond that date. Additionally, the Governor General recently declared a Biosecurity Emergency and has appealed to everyone to restrict all non-essential travel and to maintain a safe distance from others.

In light of these developments, the Committee has made the following resolutions:

- 1. The General Meeting that is scheduled for 01 April 2020 is cancelled; and
- 2. All official Club Trips leading up to and including over the Easter break are cancelled.

The Committee has made this difficult decision based upon the most current health and travel advice available. The health and safety of our Members remains paramount. We all have a responsibility, to ourselves and to other Club Members, to take preventative action and to minimise the risk of transmission. This includes Members refraining from engaging in unofficial or informal trips and gatherings.


We appreciate the magnitude of this decision on the proper functioning of our Club and we thank our Members for their understanding in these challenging and unprecedented times.
