4WD Requirements and Tips

Welcome New Member,

We hope that you've been welcomed into the club and have had the opportunity to speak with other members.

The following has been put together to ensure that as you plan to join your first trip you can do so safely and enjoyably to get the most out of your 4WD and your time with VFWDC.

What do I need on my 4WD

The below is a list of "minimum" requirements, it is not a hard rule to have all these things straight away. We do advise you to get these ASAP. Note: Access to some trips will be limited if your car is not set up.

- A 4WD with low range.
- All Terrain or Mud Terrain Tyres.
- Rated Recovery Points on the front and back of your vehicle, and a recovery kit.
 Recovery kit should contain a snatch strap, winch extension rope, bow shackles or soft shackles and gloves. Ensure your recovery kit is a rated to suit your vehicle and meets Australian Standards.
- Air compressor (We advise spending a bit more to get a good quality compressor)
- UHF / CB radio. A handheld is ok.
- A tyre deflator

What do I need in my 4WD

- Personal Details form in the Glove Box (Download from our website)
- Food and Water (Even on day trips we advise you have enough food and water for an additional day)
- A First Aid Kit
- Warm clothes and a blanket (Even in summer the High Country can turn very cold
- A sense of adventure.

Other Tips

- Speak to other members, we all have experience setting up our vehicles and preparing for trips.
- When travelling in winter diesel cars need to have winter fuel or additives to prevent fuel gelling.
- Ask Questions
- Have fun and we can't wait to join you on the tracks!
